Heart Havens is a ministry of the United Methodist Church in Virginia that develops and operates homes that provide a creative approach to community residential living for adults with cognitive disabilities. **Heart Havens** is a non-profit organization licensed by the Virginia Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services, and is approved by the Internal Revenue Service to receive tax deductible contributions. Currently, there are ten homes in full operation: Virginia Beach, Norfolk, Kilmarnock, Newport News, Colonial Beach, Stuarts Draft, Lynchburg, Richmond (2) and Winchester .
